
Using Connects

- Connects are tokens that you use to submit proposals
- 15 cents a piece: jobs are from 1-6 connects
- New freelancers are given an allotment of free connects
- Invites from clients are free

- A communication plan






Test Project

A test project can be a small milestone or A few hours of work to help you both:

- Sharpen the focus of the project
- Try different approaches
- Confirm if the timelines are realistic
- Identify any other considerations



We suggest to keep all communication with your client on the platform.

Upwork Messages

- View conversations by recency / unread or categorize a view
- Create 'rooms' to contain all conversations with a person or group of people
- Receive email notifications of sent messages and reply in email
- Attach files and take screenshots
- Take notes in a personal notepad



Upwork Desktop App

- The Upwork desktop app is designed for collaboration and Payment Protection
- Everyone can use it to send messages. Freelancers also use it to log time on hourly contracts



Prior to Setting up the Contract



Before the Client sets up a contract, discuss and agree on terms:


- Contract type (hourly or fixed)
- Rate
- Timeline and deadlines
- How to submit work to the client
- Channels for communication

- Communication for progress updates & feedback
- Main point of contact
- Access any of the client's company resources, if needed
- Anything else you need to know

Communication with the Client

Once you agree to work on a contract be sure to establish open communication:

- When you will communicate for progress updates and feedback?
- Who will be your main point of contact for project related questions?
- How you will access any of the client's company resources, if needed?
- Anything else you need to know!




Hourly Rates




Hourly Contract Billing Cycle






Payment methods

Options available to you will be displayed when you add a payment method.



Payment options may include:

- Direct to U.S. Bank (ACH)
- Direct to Local Bank
- U.S. Dollar Wire Transfer
- PayPal
- Payoneer
- M-Pesa (Kenya only)

Fixed Price Project Tips

- Negotiate milestones, rates and deliverable timelines for the project
- Complete and deliver work via Upwork
- Provide edits or updates, as requested by the client prior to receiving payment
- Ask the client to fund a new milestone to continue project work or end the contract



Ending a Contract and Giving Feedback

Clients give two types of feedback regarding their experience with you:

- Public Comments and star ratings that are shown on your Work History.
 Requires minimum net contract payment of \$1 to be visible.
- Private Used by Upwork to assess a freelancer's Job Success. This is an opportunity for clients to provide information to Upwork that they may feel uncomfortable sharing publicly.



Ending a Contract and Giving Feedback

- As a best practice, ask your client to end the contract and leave feedback in the End Contract form.
- The feedback period is **14 days** from the end of a contact. The system is double-blind, which means that feedback won't be visible until both parties have provided it for each other.


Trust & Safety Tips

Upwork has a number of **security protocols** in place to allow users to report suspicious activity on our site. We encourage you to report any activity that looks suspicious or seems inappropriate by contacting **Customer Support**. Please be prepared to provide a clear account of the situation and any proof you have, such as chat transcripts and email messages.

Trust & Safety Tips



- Check with Upwork if Clients ask for financial accounts or other sensitive information
- Don't accept payment outside of Upwork
- Keep all work activity on Upwork for a minimum of 24 months
- Review all details before agreeing to sign a Non Disclosure Agreement (NDA) during the interview or before work begins, if requested
